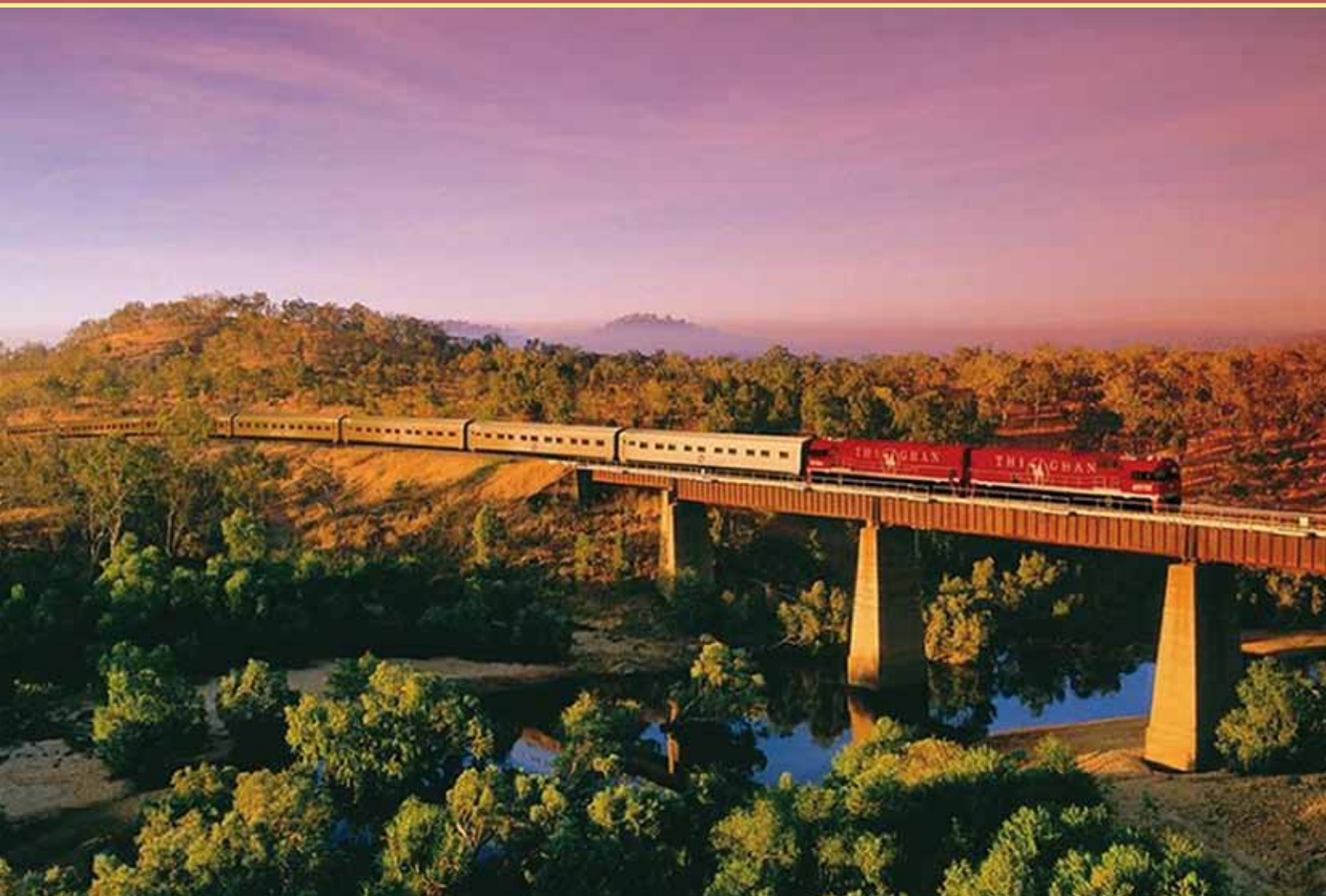

He has been using lasers in his clinical practice for over 20 years, and has lectured internationally on both clinical and basic science aspects of laser dentistry. Laurence founded a widely used laser training program, and he has authored numerous publications in laser dentistry based on his clinical specialist practice and his research work.

Overview Of The Scientific Program (CEC points available)

Begin your journey with laser dentistry, or travel to new horizons if you are an existing laser user, through this exciting scientific program. Attendees will learn of the latest developments in laser dentistry research and clinical techniques, including:

- Laser endodontic detection and debridement,
- Laser conditioning of tooth surfaces,
- Periodontal debridement using lasers and enhanced methods of periodontal surgery,
- New methods for laser treatment of both common and severe forms of tooth discolouration,
- Comparisons of lasers and conventional instruments in restorative dentistry,
- New applications for diode lasers in aesthetic dentistry, and,
- Fixed prosthodontics, and adjunctive laser procedures in implant dentistry.

For those entering this exciting field of clinical practice, there will be a painless introduction to laser science and optics, and explanations which unpacks the mysteries of what happens when laser energy interacts with tissues in the mouth. Absorb what others have learnt from their experience in practice, whilst gleaning the leading edge research findings. Scientific elements of the conference will be conducted during travel between destinations.

Journey Across Australia On The Ghan Railway
